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Eligibility Criteria:

Children with chronic health conditions who need more health services than other children, children under the age of 18, families who live in Audrain, Boone, Callaway, Camden, Chariton, Cole, Cooper, Gasconade, Howard, Moniteau, Monroe, Montgomery, Miller, Morgan, Randolph, and Osage counties. During 2003-2004, children must be enrolled in Missouri Care Health Plan, a Medicaid Managed Care Organization. This must be their primary source of health insurance. In the second and third year of the project, this will not be a requirement.

Description Of Services:

Missouri Partnership for Enhanced Delivery of Services (MO-PEDS) is a program at the MU Thompson Center for Autism and Neurodevelopmental Disorders that helps families of children with special health care needs. These children may have a developmental condition like autism, or they may have other chronic physical, behavioral, or emotional conditions that affect their ability to participate in activities the way most children do.

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
